Scriptures to Fuel Identity and Purpose

These 15 basic declarations are foundational to our identity and purpose. Speak them over your life everyday. Stick them on your bathroom mirror, in your car, and anywhere else you regularly spend time. Remember that *what* you do flows from *who* you are. These are all in first person for a more personal connection to the Word and the Father's voice.

- 1. Father, I see how very much You love me, for You call me Your child, and that is what I am (I John 3:1)
- 2. You created me in Your own image. In the image of God I was created (Genesis 1:27)
- 3. Father Your voice is telling me today, I am Your son/daughter, I am loved, and Your greatest delight is in me. (Matthew 3:17)
- 4. I am chosen. I am a royal priest, a holy nation, Your very own possession. As a result, I can show others the goodness of God, for You called me out of the darkness into Your wonderful light. (1 Peter 2:9)
- 5. My old self has been crucified with Christ. It is no longer I who live, but Christ lives in me. So I live in this earthly body by trusting in the You, who loved me and gave Yourself for me. (Galatians 2:20)
- 6. But You showed Your great love for me by sending Christ to die for me while I was still a sinner. Romans 5:8
- 7. I'm no longer a slave but God's own child. And since I am Your child, You have made me Your heir. (Galatians 4:7)
- 8. I thank you, God, for making me so mysteriously complex! Everything You do is marvelously breathtaking. It simply amazes me to think about it! How thoroughly you know me, Lord! (Psalm 139:14)
- 9. Since I am now joined to Christ, I have been given the treasures of redemption by His blood—the total cancellation of my sins—all because of the cascading riches of His grace. (Ephesians 1:7)
- 10. It's in Christ that I find out who I am and what I am living for. Long before I first heard of Christ and got my hopes up, He had His eye on me, had designs on me for glorious living, part of the overall purpose He is working out in everything and everyone. It's in Christ that I, once I heard the truth and believed it (this Message of my salvation), found myself home free—signed, sealed, and delivered by the Holy Spirit. This signet from God is the first installment on what's coming, a reminder that I'll get everything God has planned for me, a praising and glorious life. (Ephesians 1:11-14)
- 11. Yet even in the midst of all these things, I triumph over them all, for You have made me to be more than a conqueror, and Your demonstrated love is my glorious victory over everything! (Romans 8:37)
- 12. I am a new creation in Christ, I am Your workmanship created in Christ Jesus. Therefore I have the mind of Christ and the wisdom of God is formed within me. (II Corinthians 5:17; Ephesians 2:10; I Corinthians 2:16)
- 13. The joy of the Lord is my strength. Lord, You are the strength of my life. (Nehemiah 8:10; Psalm 27:1)
- 14. I am an overcomer and I overcome by the Blood of the Lamb and the word of my testimony. (Revelation 12:11)
- 15. There is no lack for my God supplies all of my need according to His riches in glory by Christ Jesus. (Philippians 4:19)
